Think of a different starting number and follow the chain.

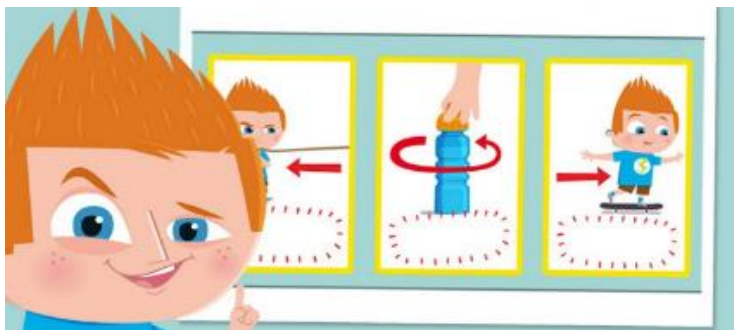
