Art: Children will be experimenting with **water colour** and making **prints**.

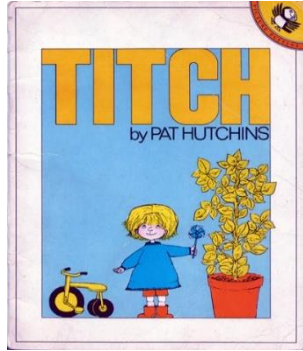
They will mix **primary** colours to create **secondary** colours. They will explore what it means to **blot**, **spatter** and **buckle** all while reflecting on their work.

Triassic 252-201 Ma	Jurassic 201-145 Ma	Cretaceous 145-66 Ma

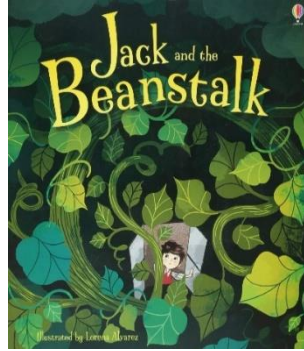


We will learn about **Mary Anning**, an English palaeontologist who discovered **fossils**. We will look at her life and plot significant events on a **timeline**.

The Mesozoic Era is composed of the **Triassic**, **Jurassic** and **Cretaceous** Periods.

Children will learn about dinosaurs, focusing on the ones listed below. They will identify the **similarities** and **differences** between dinosaurs.



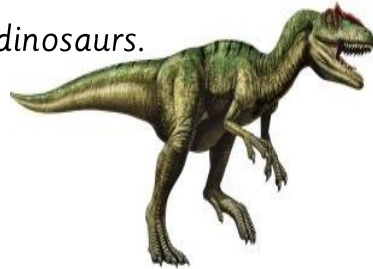
Children will understand that dinosaurs as we know them are **extinct**, which means that the **species** has died out.



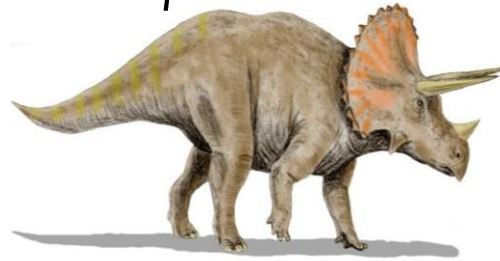
Tyrannosaurus Rex



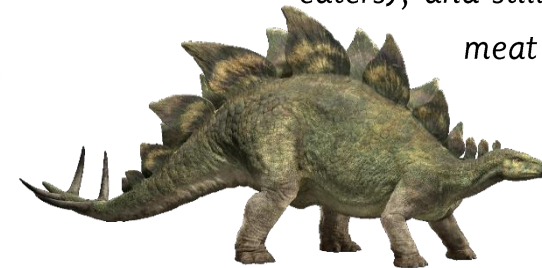
Velociraptor



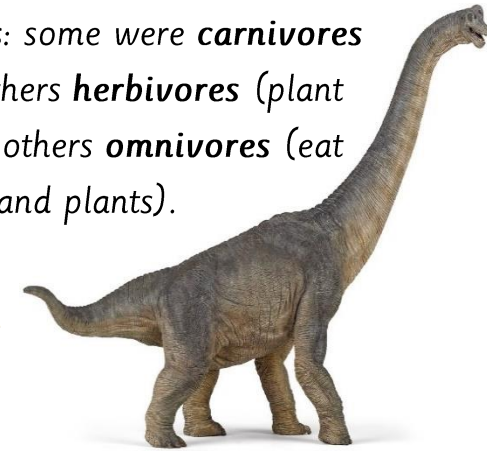
