The key skills children will be developing:

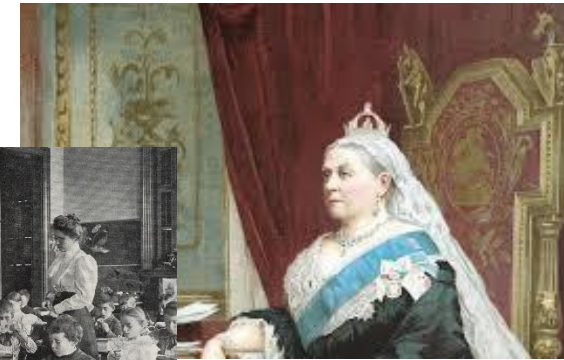
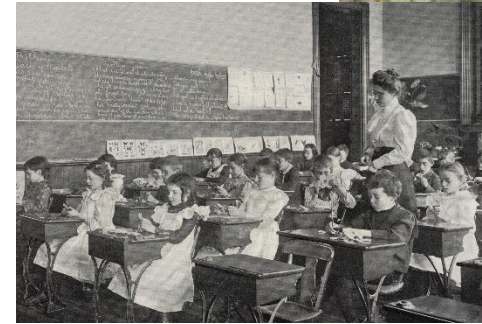
Research: Finding out a range of information from the internet and other sources.
