Think about someone who you may not have seen in your family, or a close friend, since the country went into Lockdown. How do you think they would feel if you were to send them a letter or postcard?


Can you and your family sit together and write someone a letter telling them what you have been doing at home and how you are feeling.

Look around the house and in your toy box. Select 5 or 6 teddies or dolls. Estimate their length in centimetres (cm).


Then measure each one with a ruler.
