### MR OAKLEY'S ROLE IN GOVERNANCE:

The head teacher's role in governance is to formulate aims objectives and policies for governors to consider. By creating clear targets and a broad and balanced contextual curriculum, with the governors' support and challenge, my purpose is to provide all children the opportunities to ensure that they reach their potential and are as ready for junior school as possible. I have a delegated role of responsibility from the Baylis Court Trust to fulfil for the management and organisation of the staff and teaching and learning.

In order to fulfil my role effectively I have a Leadership Team that have designated areas to report back to the School Governance Committee so that they can be secure the school is making rapid progress and that this continues. Reporting to governors can be in a range of modes, for example via a Headteacher's report or an achievement report based on school attainment, attendance and progress data. Sometimes staff come in and present on an area of the curriculum that they are responsible for. Governors also collate information by visiting the school and speaking to the children, staff and parents.
