Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 - Autumn 1 - 2017



Literacy

Phonics

 Year 2 will have 30 minutes of RWInc spellings and reading each morning.

Talk for Writing

 We are starting a new writing process across the school called 'Talk for Writing'. It's a story-telling process which helps children build a bank of narrative patterns they can use when creating their own stories. The children will have 1 hour of writing each day. This half term, Year 2 will read 'The Magic Porridge Pot' and 'Mister Magnolia' by Quentin Blake.

PSHE / RE

PSHE

 Year 2 will be learning about their environment; considering the wider community and democracy; and discussing rights/responsibilities.

RE

 Year 2's theme is 'Special Places'. They will be looking at, and learning about, sacred buildings for a number of different religions.

Science, History, Geography, Art & Design, D&T and Computing

Science

 Year 2 will be learning about everyday materials.

Topic

- This half term's theme is MUCK, MESS AND MIXTURES! We will be focusing on Art and Design, Design and Technology and Writing.
- Year 2 will be creating multi-coloured prints using techniques such as marbling; learning about different artists such as Andy Warhol and Carl Warner; and designing/making their own clay tile.
- Year 2 will be putting on an art exhibition for parents/carers during the last week of half term!

Computing

 Year 2 will be completing simple computer programs using Purple Mash and using them to consolidate their learning in the other curriculum areas.

Mathematics

Maths

- Year 2 have started a new Maths scheme called 'Rising Stars'.
- Year 2 will be comparing and ordering 2-digit numbers; partitioning numbers in different ways; ordering lengths; using number bonds and fact families to solve addition and subtraction problems to 20; adding and subtracting ones; adding three single-digit numbers; adding and subtracting tens; and exploring patterns and properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Physical Education

- Year 2 will have specialist PE tuition this term for half their PE allocation.
- The children will be learning about ball skills and coordination.
- They will learn to pass and dribble; throw over/under arm; and learn the correct chest pass technique.

How to Support Your Child at Home

 Please read with your child EVERY DAY for at least 5-10 mins. Encourage him/her to point to each word and sound out any phonetic words he/she is unsure of. Spend time discussing each story's content too - the events, characters and setting.
