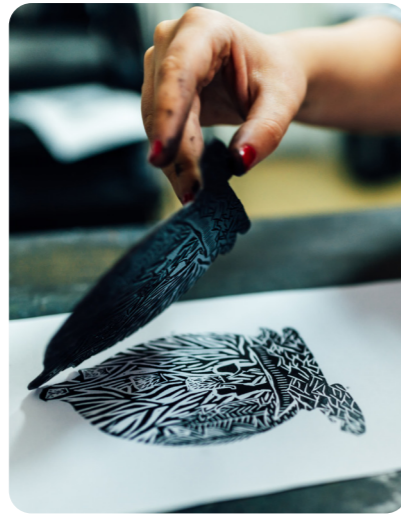


# Rain and Sunrays

## Printmaking

A print is a picture made by transferring an image from one surface to another. Different types of printmaking include block printing, screen printing and collagraphy.



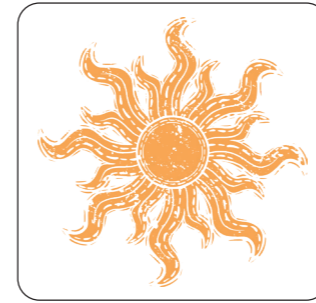
## Collagraphy

Collagraphy is a method of printing. It was invented by the artist Glen Alps in 1955. To make a collagraph, materials are stuck onto a block to make a collage or picture. The collagraph block is coated with a layer of ink. Paper is pressed onto the inked surface and then peeled off to reveal the print.

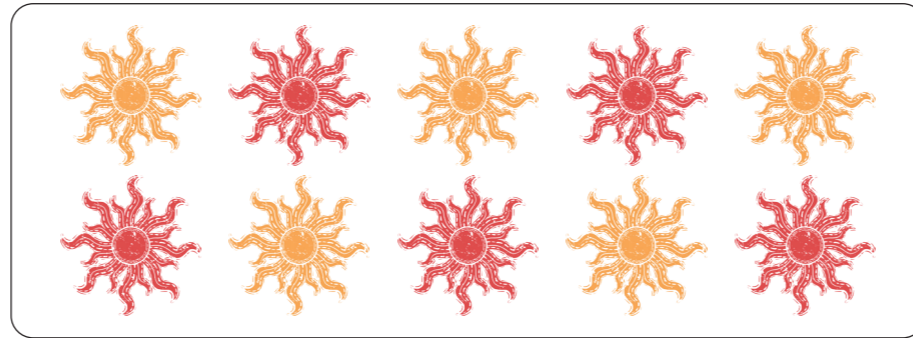


## Printing motifs

A printing motif is an image made with simple lines and shapes. A motif can be used once in a design, or repeated to make a pattern.



sun motif



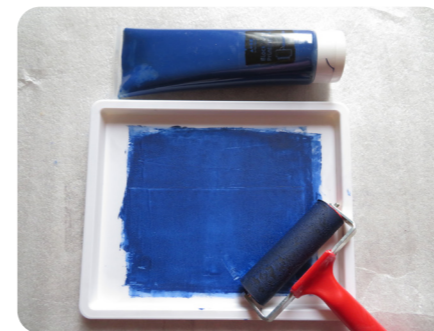
sun motif pattern

## Glossary

<b>block</b>	A flat surface, such as cardboard or wood, on which materials are stuck.
<b>collage</b>	A picture made up of different, smaller parts.
<b>equipment</b>	The tools and materials needed for a particular purpose, such as printing.
<b>ink</b>	A coloured gel or solution, used to colour a surface.
<b>method</b>	A way of doing something.
<b>motif</b>	A simple shape or image used for printmaking.
<b>pattern</b>	A design in which lines, shapes or colours are repeated.
